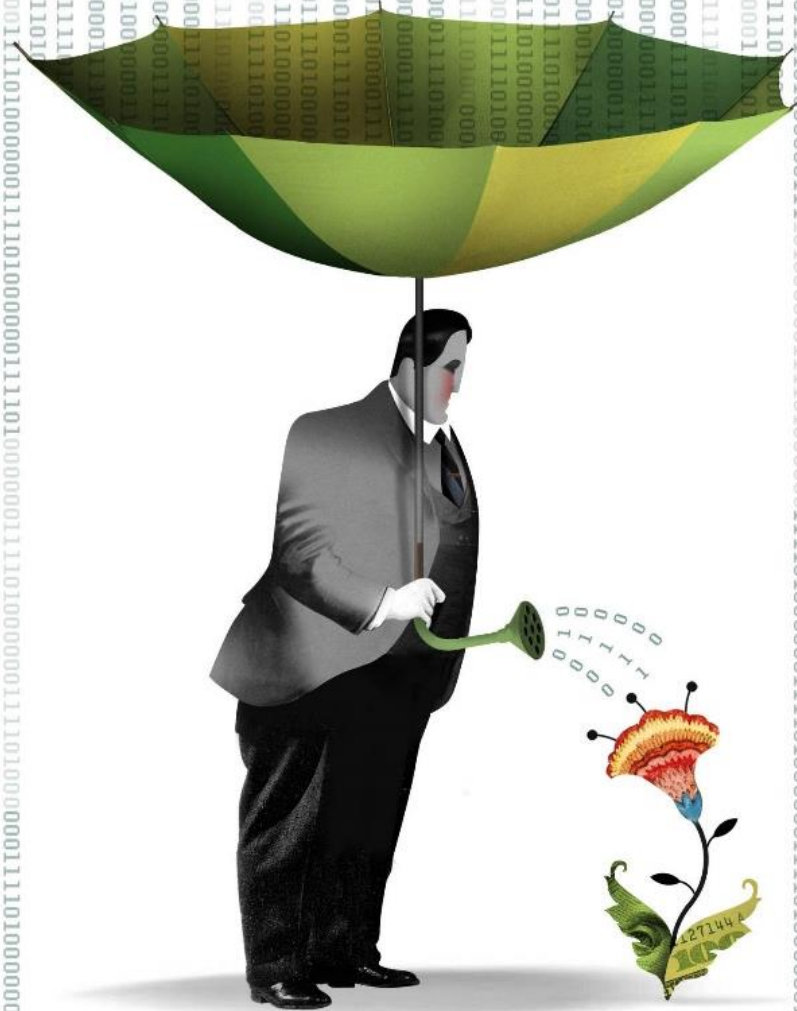

# CPs

- The winners will be announced at separate Awards Ceremonies at DB and Ing-DiBa
- All teams that passed phase II will receive in addition a **certificate** that states that they successfully completed the Data Challenge
